

## ***FUN Manual on Other Devices***

Put the *FUN Manual* on your Kindle, iPad, iPod, whatever (bonus: it's easy!)

Dear friends,

Please feel free to forward this far and wide. I will try hard to make it useful for the least-savvy computer users among us, so be patient if you find it too simple.

You can upload the *FUN Manual* and additional materials into your Kindle archive, which then can be downloaded to and read on an actual Kindle, or anything that uses a Kindle app, like your iPad, iPod, or smartphone. (If you don't have a Kindle or Kindle app, stop now. You can get the free Kindle app from the app store of your device, and you need that and an Amazon account first.)

1. Plug in your usb stick or insert the CD of the *FUN Manual* into your computer. Open up the file folder (use Finder or My Computer or click the CD icon) so that you see the title of the *FUN Manual* file with .pdf after it.
2. Open your web browser and go here <http://www.amazon.com/gp/sendtokindle/mac> if you have a Mac. Go here <http://www.amazon.com/gp/sendtokindle/pc> if you have a PC. Click Download Now. After the program downloads, click on its name in the download box to install, and follow the prompts. It will ask for your Amazon account email and password, since that tells it which kindle account is yours.
3. Click on the Kindle-with-a-big-arrow icon on your desktop. This will open a big box that says to drag stuff into it to move it to your Kindle.
4. Click on the title that you found in #1, and drag it into that box. Check where you want it sent. Then click send at the bottom of the box. You'll see a growing bar that shows the file being uploaded, and then if you open your app or device to its home screen, you'll see the same bar repeated as it downloads to the device. You can do this with any PDF file you have.

The whole process took less than five minutes to get the main text of the book onto my iPod.

It looks like you can't highlight or search :( but if you tap the screen so all the little icons appear, then tap the open book, you do get a table of contents so that you can jump around. You can also bookmark pages.
